A hybrid (BALB/c \times B6) mouse was immunized with a cytoskeleton preparation of human A431 carcinoma cell line. Fusion partner: Sp2/0.

Specifications

C-04 Reacts with keratin 18 (45kDa) present in a wide variety of simple epithelia. It does not react with stratified squamous epithelia. It reacts with epithelial tumors of the gastrointestinal tract, lung, breast, pancreas, ovary, and thyroid.

Species reactivity

Positive: cat, cow, dog, ferret, goat, hamster, horse, human, marmoset, mouse, pig, rat,

sheep.

Applications

Immunohistochemistry on frozen and paraffin sections. Dominant positive structures include a wide variety of simple epithelia, urinary bladder transitional epithelia. Positive in fluorescence tests and immunoblotting.

Format

Produced in tissue culture, contains no host Ig. Antibodies are affinity purified and presented in PBS with 0,02 % sodium azide.

Stored at 4°C- 8°C, shelf life is at least 24 months after purchase.

Dilution advice

- Flow Cytometry (1-2 μ g/million cells in 0,1 ml, fix cells in 4% PFA for 10 min, at 4°C, permeabilize with 0,2% saponin or digitonin for 15 min, at 4°C).
- **Figure 2:** Ferret alveoli stained with C-04 (paraffin)

- \triangleright Immunoblotting (1-2 µg/ml).
- > Immunofluorescence (0.5-1,0 μg/ml).
- Arr Immunohistology (1-2 μg/ml for 30 min at RT; staining of formalin-fixed tissues requires 0,1% pronase digestion (0,1% CaCl₂, 0,1N NaOH) for 15min. at 37°C).
